He joined the Post in 2000, after two years as a senior editor of The New Republic and eight years with the Wall Street Journal. He authored three books: *Tears of a Clown* (2010), *Homo Politicus* (2008) and *Smashmouth* (2001). For his thought-provoking and humorous insights, he has been showered with honors and awards, including the White House Correspondent Association's Beckman Award and the National Press Club's Gingras Prize for humor writing. He is a 1990 graduate of Yale University.
