## **What Trump's Trade Policies Mean for Workers and Politics in 2020 and Beyond**

Donald Trump promised to rip up trade deals and get tough with China, bringing back manufacturing jobs in the process. Have his policies achieved those promises? And, how should candidates for office in 2020 think about trade policy to put workers back at the center of the conversation?

Scott N. Paul is President of the Alliance for American Manufacturing (AAM), a partnership established in 2007 by some of America's leading manufacturers and the United Steelworkers union. Scott and AAM have worked to make American manufacturing and "Made in America" top concerns for voters and our national leaders through economic research, public opinion polling, grassroots advocacy, and frequent media appearances. Scott is the host of AAM's podcast "The Manufacturing Report."

Before founding AAM, Scott served on Capitol Hill for a dozen years, including six years as the chief foreign policy and trade advisor to the House Democratic Whip. He also served as the AFL-CIO's trade, manufacturing, and foreign policy advocate. Scott was a member of the White House Manufacturing Jobs Initiative in 2017. He currently serves as the Board Chair of the National Skills Coalition.

Scott earned a B.A. in Foreign Service and International Politics from Penn State and an M.A. with honors in Security Studies from Georgetown University.
