## *Current Issues at the NLRB*

We are pleased to announce that Chairman Ring will be our guest speaker at our upcoming luncheon on Tuesday, May 21st. He will discuss interesting, important and contentious issues pending before the Board. For example the Board's request for public comment on how the 2014 changes in NLRB Election Rules are working. Another is its announced Rulemaking proceeding on the issue of what constitutes joint employment. A third is the Board's public briefing on an employer's right to limit its employees' personal use of the employer's email system.



John F. Ring was confirmed as a NLRB Member on April 11 2018 and designated as Chairman the next day by President Trump. Prior to his appointment to the NLRB, Chairman Ring was a partner in the Washington, D.C. office of the Morgan, Lewis & Bockius law firm. During his 30 years with the firm he represented client interests in all aspects of labor law, including collective bargaining, workforce restructuring, employee benefits, labor-management related counseling and litigation. Most recently, he served as co-chair of the firm's labor/management practice in the D.C. office. Chairman Ring received his J.D. and B.A. from Catholic University of America. ***Please join us for what promises to be a fascinating and authoritative review of critical national labor relations issues now before the Board.***
