***The Janus Case Before the Supreme Court:
Does It Threaten Public Sector Labor Relations?***

In late February, the Supreme Court heard arguments on *Janus vs. AFSCME*. At stake is the right of public sector unions to collect fees from non-members to cover the costs of negotiating contracts for all employees. The challengers maintain that forcing non-union employees to pay such fees violates their First Amendment rights, while union leaders charge that the case is “yet another example of corporate interests using their power and influence to launch a political attack on working people and rig the rules of the economy in their own favor,” said AFSCME president Lee Saunders.
